*The 1883 Project* offers an opportunity for all of us to keep the old bell ringing for generations to come safeguarding and tending to the church building in a comprehensive way.

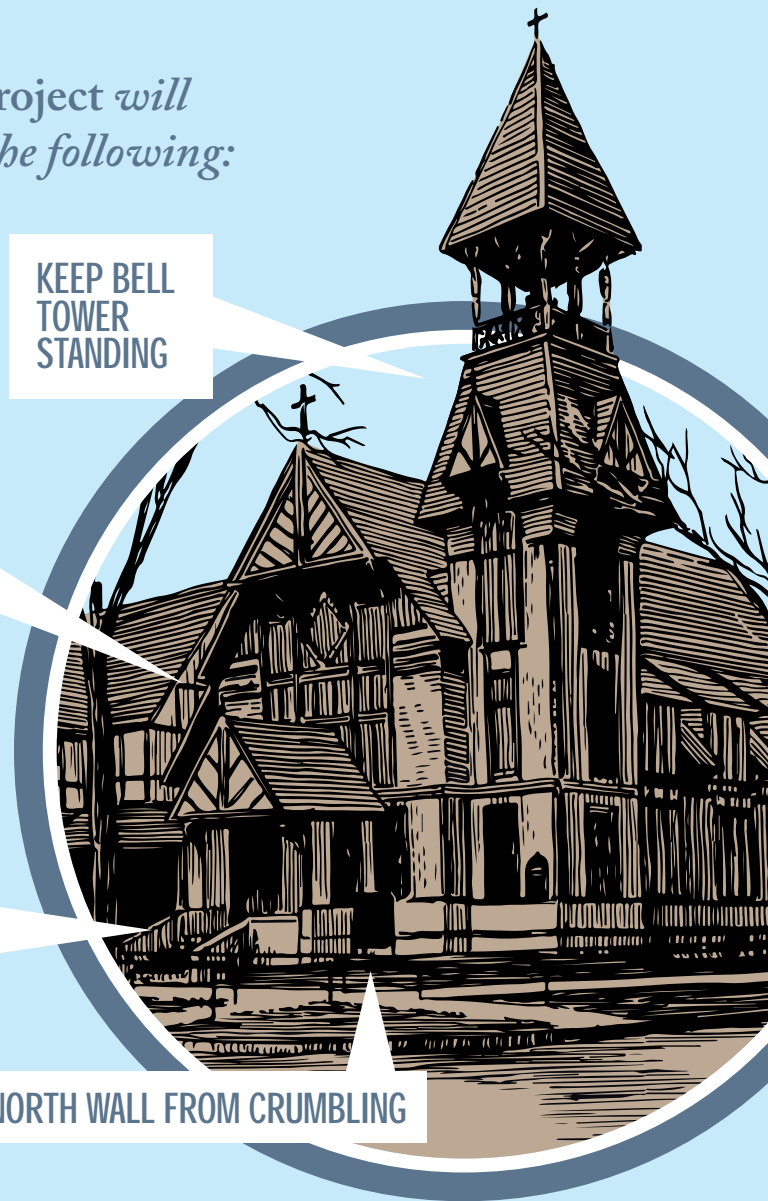
The 1883 Project will accomplish the following:

**PRIMARY CAMPAIGN GOAL: \$1,065,000**

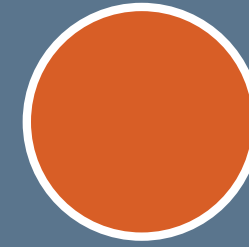
*From neighbors and church school children to lifelong parishioners, everyone has a role to play. It will take hundreds of gifts to reach our goal.*

## CHALLENGE GOAL

Should we surpass our campaign goal, additional projects will be completed. They include: rebuilding of the south façade, installing a new concrete foundation for the choir, sacristy, and hallway, and repairing and insulating the west façade.

**CHALLENGE GOAL: \$300,000**
