

## Response Rate

179 households at Trinity were exposed to the survey. 93 were returned for a 52% total response rate.

- 11 Personal Interviews completed
- 34 Electronic surveys returned
- 48 Mailed surveys returned





## Is the total project amount achievable?

44 respondents indicated that they did not know whether the goal is achievable.

35 replied that they did not think Trinity could raise the total goal at this time.

Only 12 respondents believed the entire cost of all projects was an attainable goal.





- Determine timetable, recruit leadership, and begin materials development as soon as possible.

## Recommended Goal

The amount tested for support by the people of Trinity Church was the total project cost: \$768,030.

Respondents self-indicated within a range of gift levels; the median point of that total is \$332,500.





Projects receiving the highest priority scores:

Repair Exterior, All Sections

Lead abatement, painting, lighting and electrical outlet upgrades in Sanctuary and Narthex

Establish a Maintenance Fund

Furnace: boiler replacement and pipe insulation

Replace Carpeting

The next projects prioritized by respondents include:

Correct exit doors, stairs, and fascia on Bell Tower, and service the bell, spire & finial

Replace all double hung windows and refurbish stained glass

Upgrade the elevator in the Narthex and provide handicap entrance doors

Correct exit doors from Sacristy, and replace hardware & stairs


Replace Stairs and Deck to Classroom area
